To disconnect or unhook your OWC Mercury hard drive, follow these important steps to properly dismount your drive.

Macintosh Systems (all versions): If you wish to disconnect your OWC Mercury drive without shutting down your computer, simply drag the OWC Mercury drive icon to the trash can in the dock. Your drive is now safe to power off and unhook.

Dantz Retrospect Express

To install and use the included Dantz Retrospect Express backup software, please insert the CD and follow the included installation and operation instructions on the CD.

Share your Mac formatted drive with your PC using MacDrive (optional purchase)

After installing MacDrive, your HFS+ Macintosh volume will mount as if the drive were formatted in a native Windows format. MacDrive allows you to use your OWC Mercury hard drive on either platform without having to reformat or re-initialize the volume. We highly recommend this software for anyone that is sharing data in a cross platform environment.

Reformatting your OWC Mercury Hard Drive

To reformat or re-initialize your OWC Mercury Elite-AL 800 Pro MIRROR RAID hard drive, you must use the included SoftRAID 3 software. Please install this software and follow the included installation and operation instructions on the CD.

Installation / Setup Instructions Macintosh Software Installation:

Mac OS X 10.3 and later: Install the included SoftRAID 3 software and reboot your computer. This is NOT required if you want to move your OWC Mercury Elite-AL MIRROR RAID to another computer, the software is only required to configure the RAID and monitor it's performance.

Installing directy from a Mac OS X 10.3 "Panther" installation CD or DVD requires the creation of a custom installation disc using SoftRAID's installation tool. You will need a CD or DVD burner to accomplish this. Mac OS X 10.4 "Tiger" and later DOES NOT require this step.

No other software installations are required, however, the Intech Hard Disk SpeedTools and EMC Retrospect software can be installed if you wish to use either of those utility programs.
